History - BVHPCA started in response to the pandemic by providing food to the Bayview community to include healthy food as part of their diets. Come from a legacy of cooperative grocery stores that were shut down in the 60s. Anthony worked with Mandela Produce to learn about how they work.

free for those on food assistance programs. Initiative - create a community owned co-op grocery store, building a distribution network for sustainable food sovereignty for low income neighborhoods, extending from Black/Brown farms in central California to low income households. Survey Background & Findings - (see slides for full details) 92% of respondents are shopping every week. Many people do not shop at one store in or out of the community. How have you been distributing the survey? Partnering with BMAGIC & consultant on phone banking (results not included in slides) and on the ground survey outreach, 4000+ mailers sent homes on the east side of 3rd Street, suggest putting flyers in local businesses to access surveys via a qr-code. Those who fill out the survey receive \$10 off the emerging sales subscription for a \$9 box that will be delivered or picked up at a local park/store. Located in the SF Wholesale Produce Market, distributes 400 units/week of charitable food to BVHP & D10. Amanda volunteers for a Black owned nonprofit that produces for the community by turning vacant lots into edible & herbal gardens, are you looking for distributors? Absolutely, they want to buy from underrepresented farmers. Black farmers make up less than 1% in the nation. 1st community-based organization to allocate a space in the SF Produce Market. Have you connected with the African American Faith Based Coalition; they have been working on food insecurity for years and would probably have a lot of beneficial info for you? Have monthly meetings with Mother Brown's Kitchen and BVHP Foundation to understand what duplications and gaps there are in supply and demand to best support the faith-based community. Have you identified a location, or is this in the very early stages? Doing a market study on the official location, certain locations have been identified but the biggest issue is accessibility (such as parking). Can non profits (like LEJ) take advantage of the food distribution for our summer programs for youth? Yes, contact Anthony for more info.

History: Collaborative project including Trust for Public Land, SFRPD, SF Parks Alliance, APRI and other agencies that manage public space along the waterfront. Goals (see slides for full details) - Support development in partnership with the community to prevent further displacement, address historic & systemic environmental injustices, provide more resources especially in capacity building and use this park as a catalyst. SFRPD is the principal landowner for India Basin Park and 900 Innes.

Updates & Offerings - Increasing amenities and program opportunities, addressing environmental contamination by cleaning water and land, and bringing opportunities for people to enjoy the waterfront. Construction will happen over 3 phases, see slides for details. Still fundraising for Phase 3, one area will always be open to the public. Aware that a project of this scale can have unintended consequences such as displacement &

change of ownership in places around the park. Ultimately trying to serve existing residents and locals and address social-economic issues but be mindful of investments. See slides for goals, focus, youth opportunity strategies, inter-agency collaboration, initiative budget & sources and current initiatives. Future parks will have accessible WiFi. Learn to Swim with the Y, first class will finish in June and started to ensure that kids knew how to swim so parents could relax and enjoy the water space. Construction job training specific to necessary construction trades and outlooks of future projects. Community capacity building webinars - consultant to help raise the additional \$40 million, hired local to help existing services providers to do their work in the park or adjacent. What specific community capacity are you building? Organizational capacity building. Still in the beginning of implementation, the plan is to use resources to empower the community to use the space and support surrounding organizations. Who are the private donors? Is that shareable information? Maya will send a list of donors. \$25 million from private funds, also government contracts. Are there going to be informational boards that might give history of the Bayview, and photos of the folks who have lived there? These could also be ways of helping the AA community feel welcomed and that the space is for them. Hope that the park will be a legacy space, Afro-Centric & Black safe space and acknowledging the past and future, and the community will drive the process for the park. One initiative is to ensure continued involvement in the culture and identity aspect of the physical design. Would love to work with the BVHP Black community to capture stories that are important for information boards. Lyslynn suggests working with folks who helped with the PG&E Trail and new PUC Center who are going through the same process. Expected opening date is end of 2023 or early 2024 for 900 Innes which is when Shoreline Park will close. Anthony suggests the interpretive management plan at Candlestick as another good resource. Sunrise Point interpretive panels are the first of 5 panels to recognize environmental justice, contact Charli if interested charli.baker@parks.ca.gov.
